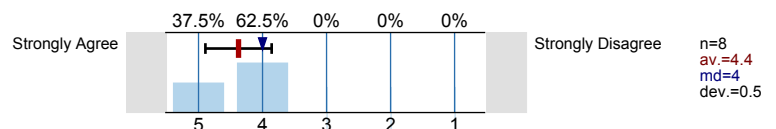

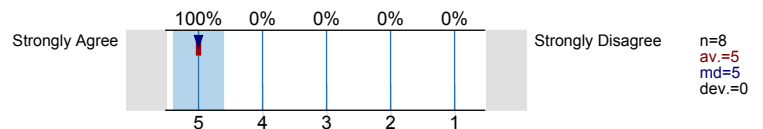

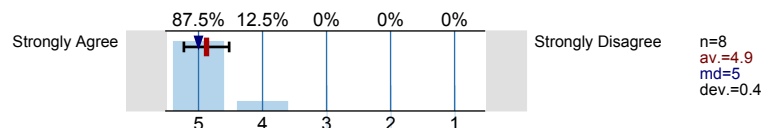
[1117] This teacher communicated clearly what was expected of me to be successful in this unit.



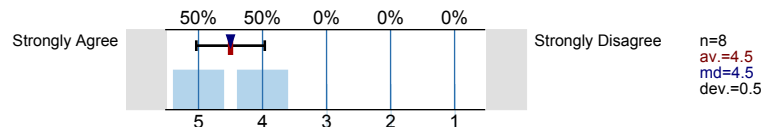
[1125] This teacher seemed enthusiastic about teaching the class.



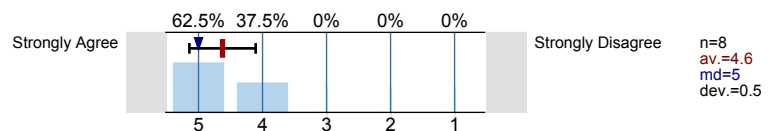
[1126] This teacher created a good learning atmosphere.



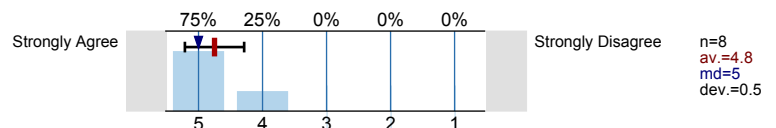
[1127] This teacher used techniques (group work, examples, online participation, etc) that increased my understanding.



[1428] This teacher gave constructive feedback (in class, on assessment tasks, etc) that helped my learning.

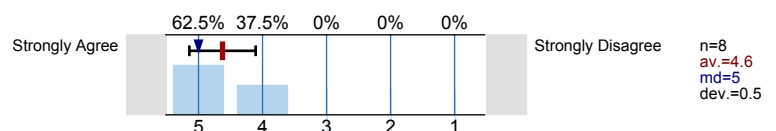


[1513] This teacher showed genuine interest in assisting students' academic progress.



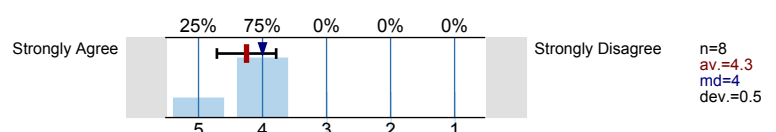
1600 Intellectual content/coverage

[1618] Intellectual inquiry was encouraged in this unit.

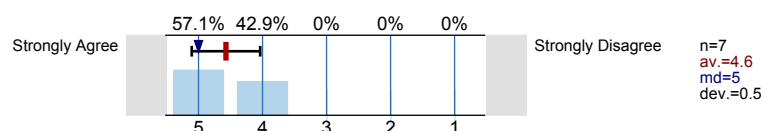


1200 Group Management/Tutorials

[1213] This teacher motivated me to learn.

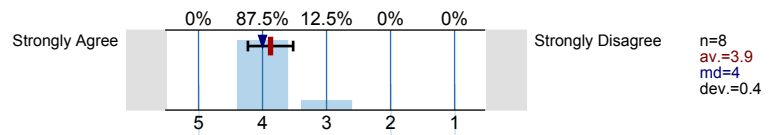


[1224] This teacher tried to make the lectures enjoyable.



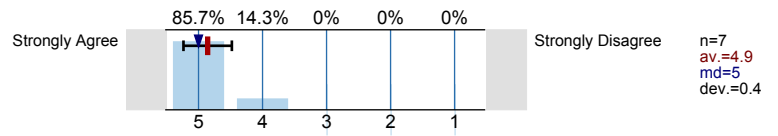

[1312] I was able to see the link between theory and practice in this unit.



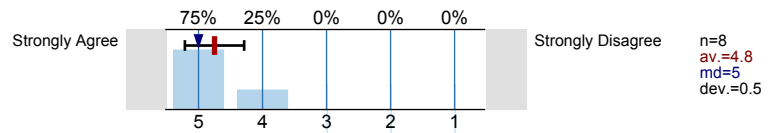
