





o1 What have been the best aspects of this unit of study?

o2 What aspects of this unit of study most need improvement?

- · The Assignments are vague which isn't always bad but as a person with ADHD, the assignment criteria and topic allowed for a lot of distractions and anxious chaotic thinking. I had to work a lot harder than my peers to try to meet the deadlines which I sometimes didn't do. it would be helpful to know/ have a specific criteria/ checklist or some sort of structure to clearly know what the assignment expected me to do. I love free and creative thinking but it is harder to do when it comes to meeting deadlines.
- Making the discussion posts more informal. Instead of doing a review of a reading for 200 words, maybe trying to do 200 words of a personal reflection that integrates the reading plus a short response to another persons post. That would encourage more discourse on the discussion page which sometimes feels like people are writing whole essays in.
- · All good
